You can revert to me in case of queries. You may take help from other class mates.

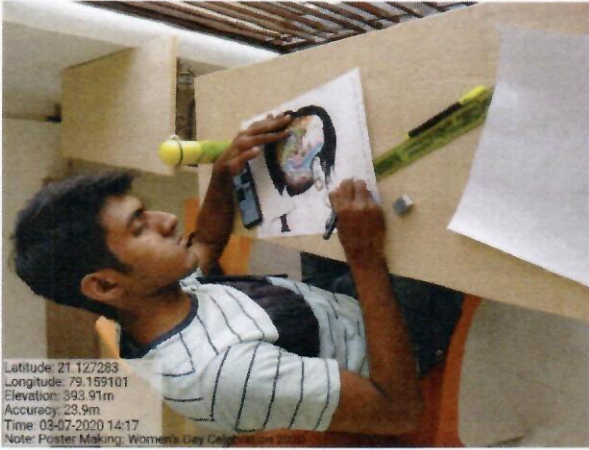

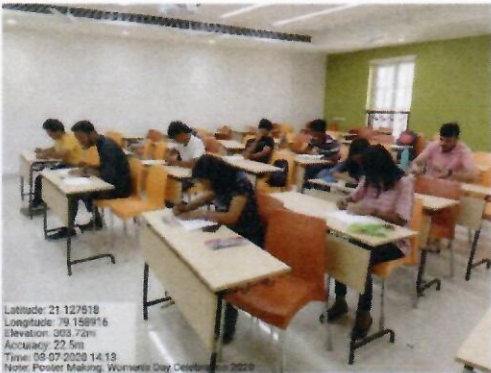
