



Extension Activity: Promoting education in the neighbouring community
A Proposal by the Marketing Club and Research Committee of SCMS Nagpur
Concept Note
Extension activities are one of the vital means of sensitizing the student's community towards the social issues. Their engagements in activities create a sense of responsibility and augment their holistic development. One of the primary ways the extension activities can be done is by engaging with the local community in order to closely observe and understand their problems and to identify the support the community needs. This could be done by organising events and activities that help in bringing together the students and local community.
The Objectives
 To sensitise the students of SCMS, Nagpur on the problems of lower income group in the neighbouring community of Wathoda Campus.
To build awareness and aspirations to pursue higher education amongst the children and parents of neighbourhood community, resulting in lowering the dropout rates from schools.
The Plan_
Since the neighbourhood community predominantly comprises lower income group, the children are deprived of choices and facilities, this result in a development of low self-esteem and aspiration. The inclination towards Higher education and discontinuation of education at early childhood has been clearly established in many studies. In a study of 15 states conducted by NCAER1, it was found that the children of poor families are less likely to be enrolled in schools than children of better-off families. If the students are engaged in some activity which may provide them with an opportunity to visit campus, know about the higher education and how education can help them build a future for themselves and their families, this will lead to building aspirations and motivate them to pursue higher education.
The Activity
A group of children shall be invited to the college campus on a Sunday and they shall participate in a drawing competition. The competition shall be open for students in the age group of 6 to 14 years. Mostly students from the targeted lower income groups from the neighbourhood community shall be called to participate in the event. This will provide this small group of 25 children an opportunity to interact with the students of SCMS. This interaction shall be focussing on the importance of education and now an educated individual helps in development of a strong nation. A visit to the campus and its environment shall help in building aspirations of the children. The student's tête-à-tête shall also be aiming to motivate the students and their accompanying parents to pursue school and higher education
The Implementation Plan
The students of SCMS shall visit the community around the Wathoda Campus and invite the members to participate in the event. The Two hour event shall begin at 10:30 Am and conclude at 12:30 PM. Drawing competition shall be followed by interaction of the SCMS students with parents and children. Prizes shall be distributed to the winners and certificates of participation shall be given to all participants.
The Budget




The activity can be done with a provision of Rs. 10,000(Rupees Ten Thousand Only) which will cover the cost of materials for competition, snacks for participants and certificates and prizes for the winners.
